

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS IN BROWNSVILLE, WISCONSIN.

Pursuant to Section 66.0703, Wisconsin Statutes and Resolution No. 2019-02, adopted by the Village Board of the Village of Brownsville, Wisconsin on March 13, 2019, notice is hereby given that the Village Board intends to levy special assessments upon property within the described assessment district for benefits conferred upon the property by the following construction:

### 2019 Miscellaneous Utility & Street Improvements

Street Rehabilitation improvements include, but are not limited to the following: storm sewer piping and street inlets, concrete curb and gutter, concrete sidewalk, concrete driveway aprons, concrete/asphalt/gravel driveways, asphalt street pavement, turf restoration, and other related construction.

The assessment district is all property fronting upon both sides of the following streets or portion of streets:

- **West Avenue** commencing at the intersection with Main Street and running south to the intersection with Highland Avenue.
- **Railroad Street** commencing at the intersection with Main Street and running south to the intersection with Highland Avenue.
- **Church Street** commencing at the intersection with Main Street and running south to the intersection with Highland Avenue.
- **Highland Avenue** commencing at the intersection with Church Street and running east to the intersection with S. Prospect Avenue.
- **S. Prospect Avenue** commencing at the intersection with Highland Avenue and running north to the intersection with Main Street.
- **N. Prospect Avenue** commencing at the intersection with Main Street and running north to the intersection with North Street.

The assessable work will include approaches within the area of curb and gutter replacement, and selected sidewalk replacement. A detailed report showing the proposed construction, estimated cost of improvements and proposed assessments will be on file in the Village Clerk's office at the Village Hall for public inspection after March 13, 2019 and available on the Village's website: [www.villageofbrownsvilletoday.com](http://www.villageofbrownsvilletoday.com)

The Village Board of the Village of Brownsville, Wisconsin will hear all interested persons concerning matters contained in the preliminary resolution authorizing the assessments and in the above described report at **6:00 p.m. on April 3, 2019 at the Village Hall located at 514 Railroad Street, Brownsville, Wisconsin.** All objections will be considered at this hearing and thereafter the proposed work will be finally determined. Final Assessments to the property owners will be made after the work is completed, billed and paid for by the Village of Brownsville.
