**A RESOLUTION TO VACATE STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY –
TO VACATE ENTIRE WEST AVENUE
AND THE WEST 220 FEET OF HIGHLAND AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined that the proposed street right-of-way vacation herein is advisable and in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, this resolution has been introduced by the village board because the village board hereby declares that the public interest requires that the public way areas herein described be vacated, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 66.1003(4)(a).

WHEREAS, this street right-of-way vacation as set forth herein has been reviewed by the Plan Commission after a public hearing according to law, and after due notice given according to law; and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this resolution the vacated area shall not be subject to public use, except that the village has secured necessary sewer and water easements to continue sewer and water service and facilities through the vacated areas, for the benefit of adjoining property.

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that it is in the best interest of the village to vacate West Avenue in its entirety, and to vacate the west 220 feet of Highland Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Brownsville Village Board does hereby vacate the following street right-of-way:

West Avenue, in its entirety, and
the west Two Hundred Twenty (220) feet of Highland Avenue,
being street right-of-way as shown on Assessor's Plat No. 1 of the
Village of Brownsville, Dodge County, Wisconsin.

This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
